
How to Teach Assessing and Managing Risk Workshop



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Aims

The aims of the workshop are to help people who are expected to teach risk management to:

- apply a systematic approach to identify and analyse what healthcare professionals need to learn about risk management
- use a model for organizing and teaching information about risk management.

The workshop assumes that participants already know about risk assessment and management.

Learning objectives

The objectives of the workshop are to help staff to:

- decide on the risk assessment and management content you want to teach
- find out the requirements of people you will teach, their expectations and future needs about risk management
- know how people learn
- decide how you will teach risk management
- prepare effectively for teaching
- test if your learners achieve what you want them to achieve and if they liked your teaching
- make changes in your teaching approach based on your learners' feedback.

Format

The workshop leader makes brief presentations and leads the participants through the work needed to achieve the stated objectives. The work is carried out by the participants working in small groups and as a whole.

Materials
